Rule 30.1 "Round the End Rule" is in effect for all starts. Code Flag "I" will not be displayed on the committee boat. A horn blast will be one minute before the Starting Signals. However it shall be the sole responsibility of each yacht to start properly.

Rule 52.2 (a) The 360° turn penalty, as provided in the rules for Infringement of a Rule of Part IV, of the Yacht Racing Rules shall apply, instead of disqualification, for infringement of rule Part IV.

RECALLS: If there are one or more premature starters or yachts which have violated rule 30.1 the Race Committee shall hail the Yachts to the best of its ability. However, it shall be the sole responsibility of each yacht to start properly. There will be no general recalls. R. C. will attempt to hail over V. H. F. channel 9.

WITHDRAWALS: Competing yachts, having withdrawn from the race shall have their skippers notify the Race Committee as soon as possible.

INSTRUCTIONS: The sailing and management of the race will be governed by the racing rules of I.Y.R.U. as adopted by U. S. Sailing. The race will be under the management of the Race Committee who shall have full and final authority. Yachts are requested to observe all rules pertaining to Commercial Ships operating within the confines of a restricted channel.

RATINGS: The ratings of Essex County PHRF shall govern this race. This means that current Essex County PHRF, ORC Detroit and PHRF -LE do not receive a penalty. Out of date or invalid certificates receive a 7 sec./mile handicap penalty.

JOG: Yachts rated under PHRF. A single headsail only to be flown at one time. No spinnakers, bloopers, RDS. Genakers etc.
